People with schizophrenia are dangerous

People with schizophrenia are wrongly identified as being dangerous through their portrayal in popular media.

Schizophrenia is caused by bad parenting

Schizophrenia has specific genetic and environmental risk factors and is not directly caused by bad parenting.
